Recruiting skilled clinicians to our hospital and community and supporting them in their new roles is critical to ensuring access to high-quality care across a broad spectrum of services. In 2025, we added six providers in areas that included Emergency Medicine, Family Medicine, General Surgery, and Obstetrics.

Investments in our facilities – from infrastructure to the latest healthcare technology – ensure that our hospital can continue to meet the community’s evolving healthcare needs. Last year, we spent nearly \$400,000 on capital improvements that included fetal monitors, heating system and water system upgrades, patient beds, surgical lights, and ultrasound equipment.
